Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections

Win Revenue Summary – July 2023

Nevada's nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total "gaming win" of \$1,403,951,426 for the month of July 2023. This amounts to a 6.69% <u>increase</u> compared to July 2022, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$1,315,969,429.

Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of August 2023

The State collected \$95,763,635 in percentage fees during the month of August 2023*, based upon the taxable revenues generated in July 2023. This represents a 5.94% (or \$5,369,403) <u>increase</u> compared to the prior year's August, when percentage fee collections were \$90,394,232.
