2021-12R: CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE RECOMMENDATION TO NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION REGULATION 5 REGARDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, DELINEATING WHEN AN AREA MEETS THE REQUIREMENT THAT IT BE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC WITHOUT ANY MANNER OF ACCESS RESTRICTIONS SUCH THAT GAMING MAY BE CONDUCTED IN THE AREA.

PURPOSE: To set out when a gaming area meets the requirement that it be open to the public without any manner of access restrictions; to allow the Board Chair or designee to recognize other areas which meet the requirement of being open to the public without any manner of access restriction; to specify certain areas which do not meet the requirement of being open to the public without any manner of access restrictions; to specify certain areas which do not meet the grandfathering of certain areas as meeting the requirements of being open to the public without any manner of access restrictions; to allow the grandfathering of certain areas as meeting the requirements of being open to the public without any manner of access restrictions; to allow the temporary closure of a gaming area to the public if the games are closed and covered; to authorize the temporary closure of ingress or egress to a gaming area for public safety reasons; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.
