**CONSIDERATION OF THE ESPORTS TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE'S RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE BOARD CONCERNING POTENTIAL REGULATORY CHANGES AND RECOMMENDATION TO THE NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION OF THE RECOMMENDED REGULATORY CHANGES.**

PURPOSE: To explicitly include Esports within other events; to allow books to accept wagers on Esports events in the manner of traditional sporting events if the books fulfill certain due diligence requirements; to specify the record keeping and notice requirements for books which decide to accept wagers on Esports events; to grant the Board Chair authority to revoke or suspend a book's decision to accept wagers on events conducted by certain Esports event operators; to set out the review process if the Board Chair revokes or suspends a book's decision to accept wagers on events conducted by certain Esports event operators; to explicitly authorize the Board Chair to place Esports event operators on the list of sanctioning organizations; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS AND DISCUSSION: No comment.**



Good morning. My name is Diamante Asberry. I'm here on behalf of the Culinary Union.

Last month we spoke to you about Station Casinos' MUD lists. These were lists of Station Casinos workers prepared by management indicating which employees were pro-management, pro-union or don't know. So MUD is acronym where M meant "management," U meant "union" and D meant "don't know." When rehiring workers it is against the law to discriminate based on union preference.

The company started using MUD lists in 2019. Then, two months after the COVID shutdown in 2020, the VP and GM of Palace Station wrote his property managers in May 2020 and said, "Our MUD list needs to [be] updated. Regina please apply the final version of our hourly cut list to our current and last edition of the MUD list so that we can review that asap."

Two months later, the Director of Hotel Operations at Palms Place told the Corporate VP of Hotel & Revenue Management, "Looking at the MUD list we have 13 GRA's we would bring back, the remaining we would prefer external. 2 Houseman we would bring back, the remaining we would prefer external." Station workers were in the midst of the pandemic and financial crises, and Station was using MUD lists decide which employees to bring back.

In August 2020, Boulder Station HR Director wrote to the property's Executive Team and said, "As discussed, all candidates that you and your managers wish to rehire need to go through a vetting process before being sent for D&B. A review of your department MUD list is necessary as well."

For what *legitimate* reason did Station Casinos create MUD lists to keep track of which employees were pro-management and which employees were pro-union? And why would it need to review these MUD lists before rehiring employees if not to discriminate based on union preference? That's illegal.

Red Rock Resorts' Code of Business Conduct and Ethics says that "All Team Members, suppliers, representatives and agents of the Company must conform to ethical and legal standards, abide by the law and preserve the Company's integrity and reputation."

Station's use of MUD lists caused damage to our community and to our industry. So we are asking you again for a comprehensive investigation into this company.

Hello.

My name is Ronal Portillo. I worked as a cook at Fiesta Rancho from August 2017 to March 2020. I was laid off during the pandemic.

In June 2019, my coworkers and I at Fiesta Rancho voted 85% yes to the union. I was a union committee leader at the time. I wore my union button at work. I was also an observer for the union during the election.

When Station Casinos laid me off, they sent me an email and told me to turn in my uniform in a garbage bag. Fiesta Rancho never reopened after the pandemic.

I applied for other cook jobs with Stations at their job fairs. They never called me or offered me a job.

Stations workers are still fighting for union contracts at their casinos. The company needs to respect workers' voices.
