SUBJECT: Version 7.1 of the Entertainment Minimum Internal Control Standards

Effective March 1, 2017

On January 27, 2017, the Nevada Gaming Control Board adopted Version 7.1 of the Entertainment Minimum Internal Control Standards (MICS) dated December 1, 2016.

No objections have been received pursuant to NGC Regulation 6.090(6). Accordingly, the Entertainment MICS will become effective on March 1, 2017. All Group I nonrestricted licensees must be in compliance with the new standards no later than April 1, 2017. The Entertainment MICS are available on the Board's website at http://gaming.nv.gov.

Although compliance with the Entertainment MICS is not required until April 1, 2017, licensees may choose to establish procedures that comply with the Entertainment MICS prior to April 1, 2017. No MICS variations or Board notification are required for early compliance.

Licensees may choose to file a new or an amended Entertainment written system of internal control (amending pages with the MICS changes). Regardless, a complete submission of the Entertainment written system of internal control incorporating the necessary changes is due to the Board's Audit Division on or before March 20, 2017.

Please note that the Board's website at http://gaming.nv.gov includes a webpage within the Audit Division section addressing Version 7.1 of the Entertainment MICS, the NGC Regulation 6.090 Written System of Internal Control Policies and additional related documents and information. The new or amended Entertainment written system of internal control should follow those guidelines as described in the Written System of Internal Control policies.
