2019-01RP: AMENDMENTS TO TECHNICAL STANDARD 3.150 OF NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION REGULATION 14 REGARDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, LIMITS ON ELECTRONIC FUNDS TRANSFERS USING A DEBIT INSTRUMENT IN A CASHLESS WAGERING SYSTEM.

PURPOSE: To consider amendments to Tech Standard 3.150 of Nevada Gaming Commission ("NGC" or "Commission") Regulation 14 proposed in the Petition to Amend Technical Standard 3.150 submitted by Automated Cashless Systems, Inc. on or about September 4, 2019, which include, pursuant to the authority set forth in Subsection 7 of NGC Regulation 14.050, removing the existing daily limit for electronic funds transfers using a debit instrument in a cashless wagering system, or in the alternative, increasing the per transaction transfer limit, not to exceed \$10,000, for electronic funds transfers using a debit instrument in a cashless wagering system, or in the alternative providing an electronic funds transfer limit using a debit instrument in a cashless wagering system that is not to exceed a per day cumulative amount as determined by the establishment, or in the alternative providing an electronic funds transfer limit using a debit instrument in a cashless wagering system that is not to exceed \$10,000 per transaction and a per day cumulative amount as determined by the establishment; and to take such additional actions as may be necessary and proper to effectuate this stated purpose.

The proposed regulation changes will be considered by the NGC in accordance with the provisions of NRS 463.145, which provides that on the date and at the time and place designated, any interested person, or their duly authorized representative, or both, shall be afforded the opportunity to present statements, arguments or contentions in writing, with or without the opportunity to present the same orally.

These items will be heard by the NGC at the January 23, 2020 meeting, and may be continued and heard at subsequent meetings of the NGC as required to effectuate the above-stated purposes.
