2020-02R: CONSIDERATION OF ADOPTION OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION REGULATION 14 REGARDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, SOFTWARE SUBMISSION AND FIELD TESTING GAMING DEVICES.

<u>PURPOSE</u>: To change the methods and formats of software submissions to the Board; to establish standards for the methods and formats of software submissions; to change the time periods applicable to field testing gaming devices and modifications of gaming devices for field tests conducted pursuant to New Innovation Beta; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.
