WHEREAS, applicants, Advanced Patent Technology, Inc., (PTC), Jack D. Solomon, President, Secretary/Treasurer and Director and 16% owner; APT Casinos, Inc., Jack D. Solomon, President, Secretary and Director; and APT Resorts, Inc., dba Colorado Belle Casino & Restaurant, Jack D. Solomon, President, Secretary and Director; have filed application seeking Commission approval, (1) to amend the Commission Order of Registration of Advanced Patent Technology, Inc., as a publicly traded company (PTC) entered, January 24, 1980; (2) register APT Casinos, Inc. a wholly owned subsidiary of Advanced Patent Technology, Inc., as the intermediary holding company and sole stockholder of APT Resorts, Inc., a corporate gaming licensee; and (3) license APT Resorts, Inc., dba Colorado Belle Casino & Restaurant, in Laughlin, Nevada, as a nonrestricted gaming licensee; and

WHEREAS, applicants, by and through counsel Frank A. Schreck, Esquire, of the law firm, Hilbrecht, Jones, Schreck and Bernhard of Las Vegas; and Howard Sterling, Esquire, of Los Angeles, California, appearing specially, at the State Gaming

2 WHEREAS, at the Commission hearing on July 24, 1980 at

4 restated applicants request for deferral of this application; and

7 mission that said applications be removed from the Commission's
8 Agenda and deferred until a later date, that these applications
9 be reinstated no sooner than the completion of the current
10 non-public Securities and Exchange Commission inquiry concerning
11 applicants stock sales to the satisfaction of the Board, and that
12 this Commission enter its Order that applicants and Jack D. Solomon
13 are to undertake no stock or stock option transactions involving
14 the stock of applicants during the interval between the entry of
15 such Order and the Commission hearing on this application, these
16 recommendations being submitted to this Commission by Mr. Jake
17 Noel, staff member of the Board; and

18 WHEREAS, applicants, by and through counsel, at the
19 Commission hearing on this matter, stipulated and agreed to the
20 entry of such Order;

21 NOW THEREFOR, it is the finding of this Commission that
22 Jack D. Solomon is a controlling person of Advanced Patent
23 Technology, Inc. and for good cause shown;

24 IT IS ORDERED THAT:


25 The applications of Advanced Patent Technology, Inc.
