1. THAT the application of Advanced Patent Technology, Inc. for an amendment to the Order dated October 23, 1980 granting approval of a registration statement to extend the time in which the registration statement must go effective is hereby accepted as filed.

2. THAT the approval granted in the October 23, 1980 Order is hereby extended to March 26, 1981, and will be withdrawn on that date if the registration statement has not yet become effective.




