AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO REVISED ORDER OF REGISTRATION

1) THAT the application of IGT for a nonrestricted license, slot machines only, at Holiday Inn South in Reno, is hereby accepted as filed.

2) THAT paragraph no. 4 of the International Game Technology Revised Order of Registration dated July 28, 1988 is hereby rescinded and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

"THAT IGT is licensed as a manufacturer, distributor, and operator of

a slot machine route, and is licensed to operate slot machines as a nonrestricted licensee at the following locations:






