#### 235 Stud Poker Rules of Play

#### Overview:

235 Stud Poker is three games in one: Two-card poker, three-card poker and five-card poker. Players make three equal bets and, if they want, the optional Hat Trick Bonus wager. Each bet is settled individually.

## **Rules and Dealer Procedures**

- 1. Set the i-Deal Plus shuffler to "235 Poker" or "Three Card Poker."
- 2. Players must make three equal bets in the spots marked "2 Card Poker," "3 Card Poker" and "5 Card Poker." Players may also make the optional Hat Trick Bonus, which pays when they win all three bets.
- 3. The dealer then presses the green button on the shuffler. The shuffler will dispense packs of three cards.
- 4. The dealer, working clockwise from left to right, will give each participating player a packet of three cards face down next to the "3<sup>rd</sup> Card" box. Keeping the top card of the packet face down, the dealer will drag the top card of the packet to area marked "3<sup>rd</sup> Card" in front of that player. The players may now review their 2-Card Poker hand.
- 5. Once all players have cards, the dealer will then take the next packet of three cards, burn the bottom one, and place the remaining two cards face down in the area marked "Community Cards."
- 6. Players look at their two cards and have a choice:
  - a. Check or make a Raise wager of 1x their "3" bet.
- 7. The dealer then reveals each player's 3<sup>rd</sup> card and leaves it face-up in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Card box.
- 8. Players have a choice:
  - a. Check or make a Raise wager of 1x their "5" bet.
- 9. The dealer then reveals the two community cards.
- 10. The dealer, working counter-clockwise from right to left, reveals each player's three cards.
- 11. The dealer settles all three main bets, plus the Hat Trick Bonus (if wagered) at the same time.
  - a. Both the main bet and the Raise wagers pay the same odds. Note: The 5 Card Poker and associated Raise wager payouts are determined by combining the player's three-card poker hand and the two community cards to make the player's best five-card poker hand.
  - b. The Hat Trick pays odds and is paid if the player wins the 2 Card Poker, 3 Card Poker, and 5 Card Poker bets; otherwise it loses.
