

3 Card Blitz

Rules of Play

3 Card Blitz is a flush based game played with one standard 52 card deck. The object of the game is to achieve the highest point total using up to 3 suited cards from the 7 cards dealt. The highest point total is 31. Aces count as 11, face cards count as 10 and all remaining cards count as their face value.

The terms used in this game are listed below:

- **Blitz** – A hand with a point total of 31
- **Royal Blitz** – A point total of 31 that is comprised of an Ace, King, and Queen in the same suit
- **Double Blitz** – A hand that contains two Blitz combinations

To begin, the player must place an Ante and Blind wager of equal amounts. Players may also place the optional Flush Bonus wager and Blitz Bonus wager.

Each player and the dealer then receive 7 cards face down and will make their highest point total using up to 3 suited cards.

After reviewing their cards, each player has the option to make a Play wager equal to the Ante wager or fold and forfeit the Ante and Blind wagers. If the player folds, the Flush Bonus and Blitz Bonus wager remain in action (if made).

After each player has made a decision, the dealer will reveal their hand and settle all wagers.

The dealer's hand always qualifies. If the player's hand has a higher point total than the dealer's hand, the Ante and Play wagers are paid 1 to 1 and the Blind wager is paid according to the pay table below (sample).

Blind Pay Table (Hand must win)

Player Hand	Pay Table
Double Blitz	50 to 1
Royal Blitz	8 to 1
Blitz	4 to 1
Total of 27 thru 30	1 to 1
Winning Hand	Push

If the dealer's hand has a higher point total than the player's hand, the Ante, Blind, and Play wagers lose.

If the dealer's hand and the player's hand have the same point total, the Ante, Blind, and Play wagers push.

The Flush Bonus side wager is based on the total amount of cards the player has in the same suit. If the player's hand contains at least 4 cards of the same suit, the Flush Bonus wager pays odds according to the pay table below.

Flush Bonus Pay Table

Player Hand	Pay
Seven Suited Cards	200 to 1
Six Suited Cards	50 to 1
Five Suited Cards	8 to 1
Four Suited Cards	2 to 1

The Blitz Bonus side wager can be configured as a progressive or non-progressive pay table and shall win based on the player's point total.

The non-progressive option wins if the player has a point total of 30 or more according to the pay table below.

Outcomes	Pay Table
5-Card Royal Flush	2,500 to 1
Double Blitz	250 to 1
Royal Blitz	25 to 1
Any Blitz	10 to 1
Total of 30	5 to 1

The progressive option is a \$5 wager and wins if the player has a point total of 29 or more according to the pay table below.

Progressive Pay Table

Hand	Pay table 1
5-Card Royal Flush	Jackpot Meter 1 [⌘]

[⌘] Note the jackpot amount will be rounded up to the nearest \$1.00 when awarded.

Only the highest payout is won EXCEPT in the special case that a player has a "Double Blitz", they receive both the \$1,000 payout and any qualifying Royal Blitz Jackpots.
