

Ace is King Plus 7 or Less Blackjack

Rules of Play

Ace is King Plus 7 or Less Blackjack is an optional side wager for standard Blackjack games played with 2, 6 or 8 standard 52-card decks.

To begin, players may place the **Ace is King Plus 7 or Less** side wager, before any cards are dealt. The wager is resolved based on three cards, the first two-player cards, and the dealer's face-up card. If the cards satisfy one of the eligible scenarios, the wager wins and pays according to the highest eligible scenario, according to the payable below:

Paytable	
Scenario	Pays
Player Pair Aces, Spades only	100 to 1
Suited A-A-9	100 to 1
Unsuited A-A-9	30 to 1
Player Pair Aces, Suited	30 to 1
Player Pair Aces	7 to 1
Player 7 or less plus Dealer 8 and up	6 to 1
Player 7 or less	4 to 1

The following notes explain further some of the scenarios listed above.

- **Suited A-A-9 and Unsuited A-A-9:** Two of the three cards must be Aces, one must be a Nine. It does not matter whether the Nine is held by the player or the dealer.
- **Player 7 or less plus Dealer's 8 and up:** The player cards must sum to 7 or less, with Aces having value 1. The dealer card must be between Eight and King.
- **Player 7 or less:** The player card sum to 7 or less, with Aces having value 1.
