

Bad Beat Baccarat – V2

Rules of Play

Bad Beat Baccarat is a variation to the standard game of Baccarat and is played using six or eight standard decks of 52 cards. Bad Beat Baccarat is comprised of various types of optional side wagers for Commission and No Commission Baccarat games.

- To begin, each player may place the base game wagers and additionally place a wager on the Bad Beat Baccarat, Super Shot Bad Beat, Super Shot Tie, Banker 7 or Player 8 side wagers. (Licensee discretion to make base game wager mandatory.)
- Once all wagers are placed, the game is dealt following standard Baccarat rules and procedures. Note: For no-commission baccarat games, if the Banker hand totals 7 with three cards and is higher than the Player hand, all Banker wagers push.
- After the Baccarat hand is completed, all side wagers are resolved as follows:
- Players win the Bad Beat Baccarat side wager when one of the hands (Player or Banker) wins with exactly one point over the other hand:
 - If a hand total of nine comprised of three cards wins over a hand total of eight comprised of three cards, the wager is paid 40 to 1.
 - If a hand total of nine comprised of two cards wins over a hand total of eight comprised of two cards, the wager is paid 10 to 1.
 - If a hand total of eight wins over a hand total of seven, the wager is paid 6 to 1.
 - If a hand total of seven wins over a hand total of six, the wager is paid 4 to 1.
 - If any hand wins over a hand total by one, the wager is paid 1 to 1.
 - All other outcomes lose. Only the highest winning total is paid.

- For the Super Shot Bad Beat, the hand values are interchangeable between the Player and the Banker hands and pay odds on the specific outcomes below, otherwise losing:
 - 3-card total of 9 wins over 3-card total of 8- pays 200 to 1
 - 2-card total of 9 wins over 2-card total of 8- pays 50 to 1
 - 2-card total of 9 wins over 2-card total of 8- pays 45 to 1
 - 8 wins over 7- pays 25 to 1

- For the Super Shot Tie, there are three individual wagers with each winning on specific outcomes that tie, otherwise losing. The tie hands totals are:
 - 6/6 tie - pays 40 to 1
 - 7/7 tie – pays 40 to 1
 - Combination of either 6/6 or 7/7 tie - pays 20 to 1

- The Banker 7 side wager pays 40 to 1 when the Banker wins with a three-card hand totaling 7.

- The Player 8 side wager pays 25 to 1 when the Player wins with a three-card hand totaling 8.

Note: The licensee may choose to offer any number of Bad Beat Baccarat side wagers.
