

- 1. Bet the Set "21" is an optional bonus wager for blackjack.
- 2. Bet the Set "21" considers the player first two starting cards and the dealer's upcard. If a player receives a pair in their first two cards, they win. Combine the dealer's up-card with the player's pair to make three-of-a-kind and the payouts get even higher. See the paytable for further information.
- 3. To begin each round, players must make their standard blackjack wagers. They may also make the Bet the Set "21" bonus wager.
- 4. The dealer then follows house procedures for blackjack.
- 5. Once all participating players have their first two starting cards, and the dealer has their up-card the dealer will settle the Bet the Set "21" bonus wagers in one of two ways.
 - a. When the cards are dealt face up, the Bet the Set "21" bonus wagers will be settled immediately after everyone receives their first two (2) starting cards and dealer has their up-card. Winning Bet the Set "21" bonus wagers will be paid and losing bets will be picked up in order of placement from the dealer's right to left. Then, standard blackjack play will resume.
 - b. When the cards are dealt face down, the winning Bet the Set "21" bonus wagers will be settled on a hand to hand basis, as the dealer goes from left to right asking for hit/stand determinations.

Note; The value of the player's Bet the Set "21" bonus hand is unaffected by a dealer's blackjack.
