

BIG BUCKS BLACKJACK RULES OF PLAY

- "Big Bucks Blackjack" is a side wager for any blackjack game of 4, 6, or 8 standard 52-card decks.
- The Big Bucks Blackjack side wager is offered as separate side-wager from the players original bet before any cards are dealt. After the initial hand is dealt and if the dealers face-up card is not an Ace or 10-valued card, the wager pushes. If the dealer's up-card is an Ace or 10-valued card then the dealer's hand is checked for Blackjack. If the dealer has Blackjack, the Big Bucks Blackjack wager wins and pays according to the dealer up-card and type of Blackjack, as defined the Pre-Deal pay table included.
- Note: Big Bucks Blackjack functions similarly to the standard insurance side wager when the dealer has an Ace up. Because the pay tables are different, the house can and should continue to offer the standard insurance wager as well. Additionally, as Big Bucks Blackjack is a separate side-wager, the house may choose whatever limits it chooses within the established gaming control guidelines.
- If the player made the Big Bucks Blackjack side wager and the dealer does get a blackjack, the players' payout will depend on the following factors:
 - The blackjack is suited
 - The blackjack is two cards of the same color
 - The blackjack is two cards of different colors
 - Whether the dealers up-card was Ace-up, Ten-up, or a Face card
- Pre-Deal Pay Table with Top Suite Blackjack:

Event	Ace-up	Ten/Face card-up
King-up, Suited Blackjack, Designated Suit	-	100:1 (Must be King-up)
Suited Blackjack, Designated Suit	11:1	50:1
Ace-up, King-down, Suited Blackjack, Designated Suit	22:1 (Must have King-down)	-
Other Suited BJ	3:1	14:1
Same Color BJ	1:1	6:1
Other BJ	1:1	3:1
