

Billy Bingo

Rules of Play

"Billy Bingo" is a variation of the standard game of Bingo. The game is called from a 75 number set of bingo balls.

To begin, 55 numbers are drawn and posted. No additional bingo balls are drawn. In the event that less than five balls are drawn in any column, then the entire 55 numbers are recalled. (example: If only four numbers in the 'B' column are drawn in the 55 number lot, the entire 55 numbers would be dropped and a new 55 numbers would be called.

Sealed 25 number (with one free space in the middle) bingo cards are sold during the next 24hrs. The cards are marked to identify them as to the date and game number.

Players will open their sealed cards and determined whether they have a 'coverall.' With the 55 numbers drawn. Winning cards will be verified and paid while losing cards are invalid.

There can be an unlimited number of cards sold and winning 'cover all' cards during the 24 hour period.

All winning cards are paid \$1,199 each.
