BLAZING BULLSEYE

SUMMARY:

Blazing Bullseye is a 5 card game where the player uses 5 cards to create a 3 card qualifying hand and 2 card point hand. The 2 card point hand is then played against the dealers 2 card point hand.

The game of Blazing Bullseye uses 1 deck consisting of fifty-two (52) cards.

The rules and payouts are described below:

How to play

The objective of Blazing Bullseye is to obtain a higher ranking two card hand than the Dealer.

After placing an initial wager on the "Main" betting area, a Player may also play the side wagers "Tie", "Bullseye" and "Suits".

Every player will receive five cards, including the dealer. A 10, 20 or 30 combination must be made using exactly three cards in order to qualify for the main wager but is not used in ranking of hands.

The remaining two cards will play against the two card house hand. If the player is unable to qualify, the optional side wagers are still in play, however, the main wager will automatically lose. If the house hand fails to qualify, all "Main" player wagers will push only if the player's hand qualified, otherwise it will lose.

The unique twist on this game happens when creating your initial qualifying hand. To make it easier to qualify, all 3's and 6's can have a value of either 3 or 6 when creating the 10, 20 or 30 three-card qualifying hand.

In the two-card hand, 3's and 6's are still interchangeable but cannot be combined to form a pair. A pair of 3's cannot play as a pair of 6's. All other cards are face value and 10's, Jacks, Queens and Kings all have a value of 10.

The highest ranking hand is the Ace of spades and any face card. Then pairs, from Aces down to 2's, mixed pictures (J, Q, K's) and finally point total from 10 down to 1.

Any hand equal in ranking, (mixed pictures have the same ranking) will result in a "Tie". All "Suits" and "Bullseye" side wagers are based on the player's five card hand, regardless of qualifying. Having three or more of the same suit or picture cards (J, Q, K) will result in a winning payoff for that wager.

Main Winning Wagers	Pays
Player wins with Ace of spades and any King, Queen or Jack.	5 to 1
Player wins with Pair	3 to 1
Player wins with "Mixed Pictures"	2 to 1
Player wins with Point total	1 to 1
Tie Winning Wagers	Pays
Player ties with the hand ranking of the Dealer's "Point Hand"	8 to 1
Both Player and Dealer unable to form a "3 Card Hand"	8 to 1
Bullseye Winning Wagers	Pays
3 Picture Cards	10 to 1
4 Picture Cards	20 to 1
5 Picture Cards	200 to 1
Suits Winning Wagers	Pays
3 Suited Cards	1 to 1
4 Suited Cards	5 to 1
5 Suited Cards	20 to 1
