



Bonus Spin for Chase the Flush – Dealing Procedures

Bonus Spin is an exciting bonus bet that allows players the opportunity to win cash and/or prizes by spinning a virtual wheel. Spinning the wheel is based on a set trigger. If players receive the triggering hand, they get to spin the wheel after the round has been completed.

To begin play:

1. Players must place their regular wagers for the game and an optional Bonus Spin side bet.
2. In order to win on the Bonus Spin side bet:
 - a. Players must have a triggering hand, a flush in their hole cards containing three cards of the same suit.
3. The dealer will then deal the base game as per the dealing procedures.
4. After the initial cards are dealt, the dealer will stop and determine any Bonus Spin winners.
 - a. If a player has a triggering hand, the Dealer will come back to that Player at the end of the round and the Player will spin the Bonus Spin wheel. The Dealer will pay the Player the denomination/prize won on the wheel.
 - If the wheel lands on a payout with a “community pay” then the dealer would pay the player that spun the wheel the higher amount and pay every other player that had a Bonus Spin wager placed that round, the lower amount on the wheel.
 - b. If there are no Bonus Spin winners, then the game continues according the house rules of the game.
5. If no Bonus Spin side bets are made, then the game plays as normal and the dealer does not have to use the interface.

Options for Top Prizes in Bonus Spin games:

Casino operators can choose from any approved payable and have a Top Prize of:

- Incrementing progressive
- Fixed dollar amount
- Prize – i.e., car, show tickets, etc.
