


Bust Bonus Rules of Play and Dealing Procedures

Bust Bonus is a proposition wager that wins if the point total of the Dealer's hand exceeds 21; i.e., the dealer busts. The amount paid varies and is based on the Dealer's up-card.

Unlike most other proposition wagers, this wager is placed after the initial round of two cards have been dealt, but prior to the Dealer revealing their face-down or "hole-card".

The Player may view the Dealer's up-card, and other exposed cards during the normal course of play and determine whether they wish to make a Bust Bonus wager. The Player must make this determination before the Dealer exposes their hole-card. The Dealer may, as a courtesy, announce "Any Bust Bonus Bets" or "Any more Bust Bonus bets" before they act upon their hand (the dealer's hand). However, it is the Player's responsibility to place the bet prior to the dealer acting upon their own hand. Claims by players that they "intended" to make a Bust Bonus bet will not be paid.

The up-card must always be the 2nd card from the dealer's immediate left, and should be pushed slightly forward (when applicable) to show the Player's and Surveillance what the up-card was.

Player's may place this optional wager providing they have first made a primary 21 or blackjack wager. Players are not allowed to make the Bust Bonus wager only.

Additionally, if players receive a Blackjack, or if they Bust during the round of play, they are still allowed to make the Bust Bonus wager. Procedurally, the Dealer will first act upon that hand by either paying the Blackjack or removing the wager from the busted hand. Following this action, the Dealer will gather together and place the Player's cards horizontally or sideways upon the primary wager bet spot. This indicates that the primary hand has been acted upon. This also indicates that the player did in fact make the primary wager and is eligible to make a Bust Bonus wager.

If the player should bust their hand with a 30, the Dealer Bust Bonus bet pushes.

Payouts

When the Dealer busts, all the winning Bust Bonus wagers are paid according to the posted paytable.

Bet Limits

The Bust Bonus wager cannot exceed the primary Blackjack wager.
