



Bust'n Loose Rules of Play

Bust'n Loose™ is an optional bonus wager for standard blackjack. This bonus wager is in addition to the player's regular blackjack wager. The Bust'n Loose bonus wager pays if the dealer's final outcome is a bust. Bust'n Loose bonus wager payouts are determined by the total number of cards in the dealer's busted hand. Player's are eligible for even higher payouts if all of the dealer's bust cards are the same color.

Once all blackjack and Bust'n Loose wagers have been made, the dealer will use house approved procedures to deal the standard game of blackjack.

The game can be dealt using one to eight decks of cards.

After all players have made their decisions, the dealer shall reveal their hole card and hit until either they have a 17 or greater or busts. There is one exception, however. If there are no blackjack wagers remaining because all players have busted out and/or received a blackjack, as long as there are Bust'n Loose side wagers remaining in action, the dealer must complete their hand if it is not 17 or greater just so the outcome of the Bust'n Loose wager can be determined.

The dealer shall settle all Bust'n Loose bonus wagers as follows:

1. If the dealer's final point total doesn't exceed 21, all Bust'n Loose bonus wagers lose and should be collected immediately by the dealer before the blackjack wagers are settled.
2. If the dealer's final point total exceeds 21, the dealer shall pay each Bust'n Loose bonus wager per the posted payable.
