

Cajun Stud

Cajun Stud is played using a standard 52-card deck of cards. To begin, players must make a mandatory Ante wager to receive two cards which are combined with three community cards as Raise wagers are placed. Players use five cards to achieve a poker hand that triggers a winning event against a payable. Additionally, players may place any optional side wagers made available.

Cajun Stud Five-Card Progressive is an optional side bet. Players are paid against a payable if they are able to create a qualifying hand that uses the player's two hole cards combined with the three-card community board.

Notes:

1. Only the highest qualifying hand is paid.
2. The highest result in the payable awards 100% of the progressive,
3. After 100% payouts are awarded, the meter is reseeded with the full contents of the reserve pot.
4. The second highest award on paytables 1 and 2 is 10% of the progressive and is not X for 1.
5. All other pays are X for 1.
6. Operators may choose to post a maximum aggregate.

Five-Card Progressive Contribution Rates

Paytable	Main Contribution	Reserve Contribution
1	24%	1%
2	24%	1%
3	22%	1%
4	22%	1%

Notes:

1. One-time initial seed value of \$5,000.
2. Seed value must scale with wager size if configured as more than \$1.
3. Progressive increments are based on the progressive wager, not the primary wager.
4. After 100% payouts are awarded, the meter is reseeded with the full contents of the reserve pot.

All 6 Bonus

The All 6 Bonus is an optional side bet. Players are paid against a payable if they are able to create a qualifying hand that uses the player's two hole cards combined with the four All 6 community cards. Otherwise, the All 6 Bonus side bet is lost. The dealer will deal four All 6 cards prior to dealing the standard game or after and place them in the designated area of the layout.

Notes:

1. Only the highest qualifying hand is paid.
2. Operators may choose to post a maximum aggregate.
3. All pays are X to 1 with the exception of the highest two outcomes on paytables 6 & 7, which are fixed pays based on a \$1 wager.
4. Operators may choose to offer Cajun Stud without this wager.

All other aspects of the standard game of Cajun Stud remain unchanged.
