

Casino Dominoes Rules of Play

Casino Dominoes is played with a shoe consisting of a two 28 card decks. Each deck consists of unique domino ranks ranging from 0-0 to 6-6. To begin, players make a mandatory *Casino Dominoes* wager, and may also place an optional wager on the Doubles side bet. Each player is then dealt three cards face up and one additional card to each player that acts as the Connector.

The player wins if one or more of the cards in the hand match with the Connector to create a point total of 5, 10, or 15 points. Points are added from across all cards that match the Connector to form the player's final point total. Final point totals can range from 0 to 40 in multiples of 5 and pay according to the paytables in Table 1.

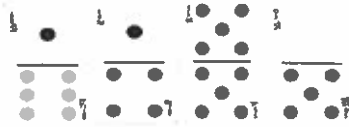

The player's cards will be scored in the following ways:

- If the player receives the 3-2 domino card as the Connector, the player will be awarded 5 bonus points. This rule does not apply to any 3-2 card dealt as part of the player's 3-card hand.
- If neither of the two halves of a player's card matches either half of the Connector, that card scores 0.
- If one of the halves of a player's unpaired card matches either half of an unpaired Connector, the score for that card is the sum of the unmatched half of the player card and the unmatched half of the Connector. Any score other than 5, 10, or 15 will be treated as 0.
- If the value of a player's paired card matches either half of the Connector, or if either half of a player's unpaired card matches the value of a paired Connector, the score is the sum of the unmatched half of the non-paired card and both ends of the paired card.
- If the player receives a 5-5 as the connector and also receives a 5-5 in the 3-card hand, the two cards will pair to score for 15 points.

Scoring Examples



Doubles Side Bet

The Doubles side bet is resolved at the same time as the *Casino Dominoes wager* and pays according to the payable in [Table 2](#). Pays are determined using all four cards dealt to the player (three-card hand and the connector). The seven doubles domino ranks are the 6-6, 5-5, 4-4, 3-3, 2-2, 1-1, 0-0.
