

## CHINESE FORTUNE 21

### Rules of Play

Chinese Fortune 21 is a Blackjack variation played using 1, 2, 4, 6, or 8 standard decks of 52 cards where the dealer may hit or stand on soft 17. Chinese Fortune 21 offers a Ten, Eleven or Bust bonus side wager in which players can win two separate payouts by only placing one wager on the side bet.

1. To begin, players must place a main game wager and an optional TEN, ELEVEN OR BUST bonus bet.
2. Each player and the dealer receive two cards according to standard Blackjack rules.
3. The dealer will resolve the TEN, ELEVEN OR BUST bonus bet, regardless of whether or not the dealer has a blackjack.
4. The 1<sup>st</sup> phase of the TEN, ELEVEN OR BUST bonus bet is based on the player's first 2 cards. If the player's first 2 cards total a hard 10 or 11 without an ACE, the player wins payouts according to the posted payable (example).

<b>Hand</b>	<b>Paytable 1</b>
Suited 5-5	50 to 1
Offsuit 5-5	25 to 1
Suited 6-5	20 to 1
Offsuit 6-5	10 to 1
Other Suited 10	8 to 1
Other Suited 11	8 to 1
Other Ofsuit 10	5 to 1
Other Ofsuit 11	5 to 1

5. If the player did not receive a hard 10 or 11 in their first two cards, the TEN, ELEVEN OR BUST bonus side bet is lost.
6. A button (lammer) will be placed on the player's original bonus wager to indicate whether the player got a 10 or 11. The player's original bonus bet must remain on the table and in play for the 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of the bonus. The button will also indicate that the player has already been paid for the 1<sup>st</sup> phase of the TEN, ELEVEN OR BUST bonus bet.
7. The standard game of Blackjack resumes to completion.
8. Dealer will then resolve the 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of the Ten, Eleven or Bust bonus side bet.

9. If the dealer busted and the player has an active Ten, Eleven, or Bust bonus side bet, the player wins and is paid according to the posted payable (see example below). Otherwise, the side bet is lost. If the dealer ends up with a bust hand, the player can still win their bonus bet even if the player's hand busted before the dealer's hand.

<b>Hand</b>	<b>Paytable 1</b>
Dealer Bust- 7 or more cards	100 to 1
Dealer Bust- 6 cards	50 to 1
Dealer Bust- 5 cards	20 to 1
Dealer Bust- 4 cards	10 to 1
Dealer Bust- 3 cards	5 to 1
