

CRAPLESS CRAPS

Rules of Play

Crapless Craps is dealt using the same procedures as Craps, with the following exceptions:

- On the come out roll, seven (7) is the only Pass Line winner and automatically pays even money. All other numbers become the player's point.
- A roll of 2, 3, 11, or 12 will not be an automatic loss and a roll of 11 will not be an automatic winner. These numbers will be marked as points.
- Odds on 2 and 12 pay 6 to 1; odds on 3 and 11 pay 3 to 1.
- All other numbers pay the same odds as the standard game of Craps.
- Numbers 2, 3, 11, and 12 may be bet on as Place bets. When this wager is made, the 2 and 12 pay 25 to 5, the 3 and 11 pay 13 to 5.
- There are no Don't Pass or Don't Come bets.
- All other bets remain unchanged from the standard game of Craps.

Note: Operator may or may not offer the Lay bet. If the Lay bet is offered a 5% vig will be taken.
