## Rules and Procedures

### **INTRODUCTION**

**Dragon Dai-Bacc** is a "Commission-Free" Baccarat game offering several exciting new optional Bonus side wagers for Baccarat players; Tiger 7, Ox 8, Kill, Rabbit 9, Matching 7's and All 4. The player begins by placing one or more of the available wagers: Player, Banker, Tie, Kill the Ox/Tiger Bonus, Tiger 7 Bonus, and/or Ox 8 Bonus wagers. If offered by the house, the player may also choose to place a Rabbit 9 wager, Matching 7s wager, and/or All 4 wager. Note, the house may choose to offer only one or two of these latter three wagers. However, if the house chooses to offer the All 4 wager, they must also offer the Rabbit 9 and Matching 7s wager. A Player and Banker hand are then dealt, as in standard Baccarat, with the Player and Banker hands each possibly receiving a third card according to the standard draw rules of Baccarat. All wagers are then resolved.

### **GAME DESCRIPTION**

- **Commission-Free Baccarat**
- **Player Wager**
  - If the Player hand beats the Banker hand, the wager wins and pays 1 to 1. If the hands tie, the wager pushes. If the Player hand is beaten by the Banker hand, the wager loses.
- **Banker Wager**
  - If the Banker hand beats the Player hand with any hand other than a three-card 7, the wager wins and pays 1 to 1. If the Banker hand beats the Player hand with a three-card 7, or if the hands tie, the wager pushes. If the Banker hand is beaten by the Player hand, the wager loses.
- **Tie Wager**
  - If the Player and Banker hands tie, the wager wins and pays 8 to 1. Otherwise, the wager loses.
- **Kill the OX / Tiger Bonus Wager**
  - If the final Player hand is a three-card 8, and the Player hand does not beat the Banker hand, the wager wins. Or, if the final Banker hand is a three-card 7, and the Banker hand does not beat the Player hand, the wager also wins. A winning wager pays 60 to 1. If neither condition is satisfied, the wager loses.
- **Tiger 7 Bonus Wager**
  - If the Banker hand wins with a three-card 7, the wager wins and pays 40 to 1. Otherwise, the wager loses.

### Rules and Procedures

- **Ox 8 Bonus Wager**
  - If the Player hand wins with a three-card 8, the wager wins and pays 25 to 1. Otherwise, the wager loses.
- **Rabbit 9 Wager**
  - If either hand has a three-card 9, the wager wins and pays according to scenario, as given in the Rabbit 9 Wager Pay Table. Otherwise, the wager loses.

<b>Rabbit 9 Wager Pays</b>	
<b>Scenario</b>	<b>Pay</b>
Both Hands Have Three-Card 9	75 to 1
One Hand Has Three-Card 9	10 to 1

- **Matching 7s Wager**
  - If the Player hand and Banker hand both total 7, and if the hands have the same number of cards, the wager wins and pays according to scenario, as given in Matching 7s Pay Table. Otherwise, the wager loses.

<b>Matching 7s Wager Pays</b>	
<b>Scenario</b>	<b>Pay</b>
Both Hands Have Three-Card 7	200 to 1
Both Hands Have Two-Card 7	50 to 1

- **All 4 Wager**
  - If a winning condition is satisfied for the Tiger 7 wager, Ox 8 wager, Rabbit 9 wager, or Matching 7s wager, then the All 4 wager wins and pays 6 to 1. If all of the referenced wagers lose, the All 4 wager also loses.

### **RULES OF PLAY**

1. To begin, Player's will place their normal Baccarat main game wagers per underlying house rules and any of the optional Bonus side wagers before any cards have been dealt.
2. Once all wagers have been placed, the Dealer will begin dealing the game of Baccarat per house rules.

3. After the first four-cards have been dealt, the Dealer will determine if any additional cards are needed for the outcome of the game of Baccarat per house rules.
4. The Dealer will collect all losing Baccarat and Bonus side wagers following departmental procedures before paying any winning wagers.
5. Once all Baccarat main game and bonus side wagers have been resolved, the Dealer will continue following underlying Baccarat rules per house procedures.
