Introduction

DiamondZ is an optional side wager that can be added to any existing poker game that uses a single deck of playing cards, with or without the jokers. DiamondZ can be added to the following games:

Pai Gow Poker
 Ultimate Texas Hold'em
 Three Card Poker
 Four Card Poker
 Crazy 4 Poker
 Fortune Pai Gow Poker
 Face Up Pai Gow Poker

The side wager utilizes the cards dealt in sequence for the base game. The game may be configured to use 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, or 14 cards dealt to the player, the dealer and community cards (if applicable).

The side wager awards payouts according to the number of diamond suited cards that are obtained between the player, the dealer and community cards. (See sample payable)

*Note: Pai Gow Poker games played with a 53 card deck, to include the joker, use a 14 card configuration. The joker is considered a diamond suited playing card for this side wager.
