

Pai Gow Plus is a side bet in Pai Gow Poker. The player has the option to bet that his hand will contain a straight or better. The game can be played by five players.

The dealer will deal 7 cards to each player and himself and 7 cards to a "community" hand. The player must place the Pai Gow Poker wager in order to place the side wager. The side wager is \$2 minimum. If any five cards of the player's hand can form a straight or better, the player is paid at the following odds:

<u>Player Hand Type</u>	<u>Pays</u>
Straight	2 to 1
3 of a Kind	3 to 1
Flush	4 to 1
Full House	5 to 1
4 of a Kind	20 to 1
Straight Flush	50 to 1
Wild Royal Flush	100 to 1
Royal Flush	250 to 1
5 Aces	1000 to 1

If the player does not have a straight or better he will lose his side wager. However, if the community hand is 4 of a kind or better, he still can win a cash award as follows:

<u>Community Hand Type</u>	<u>Pays</u>
4 of a Kind	\$5
Straight Flush	\$15
Wild Royal Flush	\$50
Royal Flush	\$250
5 Aces	\$1000

All players who placed the side wager automatically win the cash award if the community hand is 4 of a kind or better.
