

EMPEROR'S CHALLENGE

Pai Gow Poker

Emperor's Challenge

1. To begin the game, each player must make a Pai Gow Poker wager. Each player may also place optional Emperor's Treasure, Pai Gow Insurance, Emperor's Treasure Bonus Jackpot and/or Pai Gow Insurance Bonus Jackpot wagers.
2. Once all wagers are placed, the game is dealt and completed following standard Pai Gow Poker rules and procedures.
3. After the Pai Gow Poker hand is finished, each side wager and bonus wager is resolved according to the posted paytables.

Optional Bonus Jackpot Wager

Pai Gow Insurance Bonus Jackpot

The player is wagering that their seven-card hand consists of one of the winning triggering events shown in the posted payable.

Pai Gow Insurance Bonus Jackpot Paytables

The player is wagering that their seven-card hand will result in a Queen-high Pai Gow or lower, all winning triggering events are displayed below:

| Hand | Paytable 1 | Paytable 2 |
|---------------------|------------|------------|
| 9-High (Same Color) | 100% | 100% |
| 9-High (Other) | 10% | 10% |
| 10-High | \$125 | \$100 |
| Jack-High | \$30 | \$25 |
| Queen-High | \$7 | \$10 |
| Other | Loss | Loss |

Notes:

1. All odds shown above are "for 1."
2. Ace is always high.
2. Only the highest qualifying hand is paid.
3. The bonus jackpot wager is independent of the main game's win-loss result.
