

EMPTY THE RACK BLACKJACK

RULES OF PLAY

1. "Empty The Rack Blackjack" is an optional bonus wager that has no effect on the underlying base game of Blackjack.
2. At the start of the hand, prior to the dealing of any cards, the player has an option to play "Empty The Rack Blackjack" by placing their desired wager amount in the "Empty The Rack Blackjack" bonus wager circle.
3. The "Empty The Rack Blackjack" bonus wager pays odds based upon the player's first two cards and the dealer's first two cards, according to the tables listed below:

*Player vs Dealer suited BJ doesn't need to be the same suit

*Players DO NOT need to split or double to be paid

*Player hands apply to Player's first two cards
