

## Fast Action Roulette

Fast Action Roulette is a modification to the traditional game of Roulette with the addition of Bonus Numbers and higher payouts. Fast Action Roulette also offers side bets that pay up to 350 to 1.

### How to Play

Each Round, once all bets are placed and no more bets is called, 10 Bonus numbers will be illuminated on the layout and also displayed on the results sign. If the winning number outcome on the roulette wheel is also one of the Bonus numbers, wagers on the winning number outcome betting area and the side bet bonus betting areas may be eligible for a Bonus win (see pay tables and figures of bonus betting below).

See below for payouts and bet locations.

## **B Method of Play**

The cloth layout for the table game is as shown in Figure 1, including all the available playing areas for placement of player wagers. Figure 2 provides examples of the placement of the available wagers. Figure 3 shows the quad-array configuration used to determine "Super Bonus" numbers.

## **C How to Play**

- C.1** Commencement of play starts when the Dealer initiates the place your bets phase of the game.
- C.2** The conclusion of player bets takes effect when the Dealer indicates to the players no more bets are to be placed.
- C.3** A Player places one or more wagers using cash chips and/or color chips on any of the available betting areas on the layout (listed in C.4).

Each wager in a specific betting area may be placed by individual or multiple players in accordance with the table minimum and maximum limits.

- C.4** Player wagers on the numbers are placed as follows and as shown in Figure 2:
  - C.4.1** Straight Up – centrally inside the desired number betting area.
  - C.4.2** Bonus – inside the betting area labeled "Bonus Win".
  - C.4.3** Super Bonus – inside the betting area labeled "Super Bonus Win".
- C.5** The Dealer may, at the request of a player, assist the player to position wagers in the betting areas prior to "no more bets" being indicated by the dealer. It is the player's responsibility to ensure that the wager placement of the players chips/wagers is carried out correctly.
- C.6** The Dealer will initiate the spin the ball in the ball track in the opposite direction to the rotation of the wheel. The ball will complete at least four revolutions around the ball track of the wheel to constitute a valid spin for that round of play.
- C.7** While the ball is still rotating around the ball track of the wheel, the Dealer will indicate no more bets to the players, to indicate the closing of bets of the current round of play.
- C.8** The winning number for that round of play shall be determined based on the pocket in which the ball will come to a final rest. Once the ball has come to a final rest in a pocket of the wheel, the dealer will announce the winning number and will place the dolly on the corresponding number on the layout.
- C.9** After the ball comes to rest in a pocket on the wheel, any wagers on the layout that were not placed clearly or inadvertently moved after no more bets was indicated, the Supervisor or above shall determine the treatment of the particular wagers on the layout. As stipulated in C.5, It is the player's responsibility to ensure that wagers are correctly placed on the layout.
