Runner-Runner - Version 2TM - Game Submission

Our modification of the standard game of **Caribbean Stud** and **Five Star Stud Versions 1 & 2** offers an optional side wager that can be played alone or in combination with the primary wager. The **Runner-Runner** TM **Version 2** side wager utilizes the player's five card poker hand which is combined with two community cards to create a 7-Card Stud poker hand. The 7-Card Stud poker hand plays against the enclosed pay tables and wins with three-of-a-kind or better. The **Runner-Runner** TM **Version 2** wager is still in play even if a player folds their 5-Card poker hand.

Playing the Runner-Runner ** Version 2 game in combination with a 5-Card Poker game

When a Player makes a Runner-RunnerTM - V2 wager and a 5-Card Poker wager, their 5-Card Poker hand will play out normally as per standard game protocol. If the Player chooses to fold their 5-Card Hand, they are required to tuck their cards under their Runner-RunnerTM - V2 wager signifying to the Dealer that they forfeit their 5-Card Poker wager(s) and that they are only interested in playing the Runner-RunnerTM - V2 side wager to completion.

If the Player likes their 5-Card Hand and plays it to completion as per standard 5-Card Poker protocol, their **Runner-Runner**TM - **V2** side wager will play out at the completion of the standard 5-Card Poker hand.

Once the 5-Card Poker hand has completed and the Dealer has paid and taken as necessary, all players without a **Runner-Runner** - **V2** wager will see their 5-Card Poker hand removed and placed into the discard rack. Players with a **Runner-Runner** TM - **V2** wager will see their initial five cards remain in play.

When it comes time to play the Runner-Runner[™] - V2 game, the Dealer will reveal two additional community cards in the middle of the layout. These two community cards will combine with a Player's five cards to form a 7-Card poker hand. A Player's 7-Card Poker hand will then need to qualify against a posted pay table to qualify as a winner and receive payment. All hands that fail to qualify will see their losing wagers collected by the dealer.

Playing the **Runner-Runner**[™] - **V2** game alone

If a player makes a Runner-Runner[™] - V2 side wager alone, the player is making a wager on a 7-Card Stud Poker hand and will be dealt their seven cards in two parts. The Player will receive their initial five cards from the Dealer (as in 5-Card Stud) at the start of the hand followed by two additional community cards once the 5-Card poker hand has concluded.
