

Four Card Prime

Four Card Prime is a played using a standard 52-card deck of cards. To begin, players must make a mandatory Ante wager to receive five cards to play against the dealer's six-card hand. Players use five cards to achieve a higher four-card poker hand than the dealer who uses six cards. Additionally, players may place any optional side wagers made available.

Four-Card Progressive is an optional side bet. Players are paid against a payable if they are able to create a qualifying hand that uses the player's five cards to match a winning triggering event.

4. After 100% payouts are awarded, the meter is reseeded with the full contents of the reserve pot.
5. All pays are X for 1.
6. Operators may choose to post a maximum aggregate.
7. Operators may choose to offer Four Card Prime with or without this wager.

Five-Card Progressive is an optional side bet. Players are paid against a payable if they are able to create a qualifying hand that uses the player's five cards to match a winning triggering event.
