

Golden Frog Baccarat

Rules of Play (Version 2)

Golden Frog Baccarat offers several optional side wagers to the standard game of Baccarat. The game is played using six or eight standard decks of 52 cards and is available for play on Commission and No Commission Baccarat games.

To begin, each player may place the standard base game wagers and additionally place a wager(s) on the Jin Chan 7, Koi 8, 3 card 9 over a 3 card 7, 3 card 9 over 3 card 1, Natural 9 over 2 card 7 or Any 8 Over Any 6. (Licensee discretion to make base game wager mandatory.)

- Once all wagers are placed, the game is dealt following standard Baccarat rules and procedures. Note: For no-commission baccarat games, if the Banker hand totals 7 with three cards and is higher than the Player hand, all Banker wagers push.

- After the Baccarat hand is completed, all side wagers are resolved as follows:
 - ~ If the Banker wins with a three-card hand total of 7, the Jin Chan 7 side wager pays 40 to 1.
 - ~ If the Player wins with a three-card hand total of 8, the Koi 8 side wager pays 25 to 1.
 - ~ If a hand has a total of 9 comprised of three cards and the other has a total of 7 comprised of three cards, the 3 Card 9 Over a 3 Card 7 wager is paid 200 to 1.
 - ~ If a hand has a total of 9 comprised of three cards and the other has a total of 1 comprised of three cards, the 3 Card 9 Over 3 Card 1 wager is paid 150 to 1.
 - ~ If a hand has a total of 9 comprised of two cards and the other has a total of 7 comprised of two cards, the Natural 9 Over 2 Card 7 wager is paid 50 to 1.
 - ~ If a hand has a total of 8 and the other has a total of 6, the Any 8 Over Any 6 is paid 25 to 1.
