Game Description

Golden Talons is a Baccarat game containing a set of optional bonus wagers using 6 or 8 standard, 52-card decks. The object of the Golden Talons is for the selected hand to be natural winner, part of a natural tie, or a non-natural winner by 4 or more points. The game can be played on standard commission or commission-free versions of Baccarat. The outcomes of the optional bonus wagers are not dependent on the base game's outcome.

Note that any combination of the available wagers may be offered:

- On any standard Baccarat game (non-branded).
- In conjunction with any other branded game/wagers, under an alternate name (e.g., Rising Phoenix Baccarat with Golden Talons, etc.)

Rules of Play

- 1. To begin each round, players must place a main game wager and may also place any optional bonus and/or progressive wagers.
- 2. Once all wagers are placed, standard baccarat dealing procedures are followed. All main game wagers are reconciled in the following manner:
 - a. If the PLAYER hand wins.
 - i. The PLAYER wager wins and pays 1 to 1
 - ii. The BANKER and TIE wagers lose
 - b. If the BANKER hand wins,
 - i. The BANKER wager wins and pays 1 to 1, minus commission (if applicable)
 - ii. The PLAYER and TIE wagers lose
 - If the hands are tied.
 - i. The TIE wager wins and pays 8 to 1
 - ii. The PLAYER and BANKER wagers push
- 3. All optional wagers are reconciled based on their evaluation criteria.

Optional Bonus Wagers

Operators choose which optional bonus wager(s) they will offer and set all minimum and maximum wagering limits.

Golden Talons

A Golden Talons wager may be placed on the PLAYER hand, BANKER hand, or both. Players win if their selected hand is a natural winner or a non-natural winner by a specific number of points. Wins are paid according to the corresponding paytable in Appendix A.

Harmony Progressive

Players win if the PLAYER and BANKER hands tie and are paid based on the specific scenario as listed on the corresponding paytable in Appendix B.
