



## **RULES OF PLAY**

Golden Tie is an optional progressive side wager for commission and non-commission Baccarat games that utilize a shoe with eight standard 52 card decks.

- Players must make a standard Baccarat wager to be eligible to play the progressive wager.
- Before each hand of Baccarat is dealt, the progressive system randomly generates a unique number from 0 to 9 for each participating player.
- The progressive wager wins according to the paytable posted when a certain TIE is dealt during the main game of Baccarat. Note: Not all ties qualify for payouts.
- If the number randomly generated for the participating progressive player, 'Matches' the point total of the tie, the player will receive a higher payout according to the posted paytable.

### **Definitions:**

**6 Card Tie** - a tie where the player and banker are each dealt a third card.

**Any Tie** - a tie involving 4, 5 or 6 cards of suited or mixed suits, same color or mixed colors.

**Match** - the payout is higher if the number randomly generated for the player matches the point total of the tie. See sample paytables

MATCH - Any Tie	10 For 1
Any Tie	2 For 1

**Progressive Winners:**

- a) The percentage pays are paid from the progressive jackpot shown on the progressive meter. Other hands are paid from the tray or from the meter at the casino's requirements.
- b) The percentage prize shown on the meter is paid to the player position with the winning combination
- c) When a player has a progressive winner, the dealer, using the dealer display will press the appropriate hand button that corresponds to the player with the winning progressive hand and tap confirm. The dealer will type in their pin number confirm to put jackpot in a pending state. (During a jackpot payment, the last entry may be cancelled by tapping the check mark.)
- d) The dealer shall then contact a supervisor.
- e) Once the casino verifies the progressive win, the supervisor will press the pending button on the dealer station, select the award, confirm and type in the Supervisor pin number. The winner information will be displayed on the progressive screen. This records the win onto the PRSM computer and adjusts the meter appropriately for the prize won. House procedures are then followed for paying the prize.
- f) Once the dealer has reconciled all action, they press "STOP and CONFIRM." This resets the system to begin the next hand.
- g) Once the Supervisor or Manager pin is entered and confirmed the prize is logged into PRSM. If the progressive pay needs to be backed out at this point, the award will need to be manually backed out using the PRSM computer system and clicking on the Jackpot Adjustment window.
