HIGH CARD FLUSH

High Card Flush is played using one standard 52-card deck. At the beginning of each game, the player places a standard High Card Flush Ante wager and may optionally place a Flush, Straight Flush and/or High Card Flush Progressive wager. Each player and the dealer then receive seven cards.

The High Card Flush Progressive pays against a paytable if the player is able to create a qualifying hand using their seven cards, even if the player folded their hand on the Ante/Raise wager.

Notes:

- 1. All pays are "for 1."
- 2. Only the highest qualifying hand is paid.
- 3. An Ace may be used as either the lowest or highest rank of the suit.
- 4. The above paytables are based off a \$1 wager. If the progressive is configured with a different base wagering unit, the seed/reseed and player pays should be multiplied accordingly.

All other aspects of the standard game of High Card Flush remain unchanged.
