

# High and Low Craps

## Rules of Play

High and Low Craps consists of two bets that are resolved after a single roll of the dice. The player can wager on either one; High or Low, or both, at any time. The player predicts that the accumulated total of points that appear on both die will result in a low or high number. The Low bet is the dice combination of 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6. The High bet is the dice combination of 8, 9, 10, 11, or 12. Both bets are lost with a dice combination of 7. The player is paid according to the following paytables:

<b>Low Wager Roll 3-6 Pays 1 to 1</b>	
<b>ROLL</b>	<b>PAYS</b>
2	1 to 1
3	2 to 1
4	3 to 1
5	4 to 1
6	5 to 1
7	6 to 1

<b>High Wager Roll 8-11 Pays 1 to 1</b>	
<b>ROLL</b>	<b>PAYS</b>
8	1 to 1
9	2 to 1
10	3 to 1
11	4 to 1
12	5 to 1
7	6 to 1

All other bets remain unchanged from the standard game of Craps.
