

Insurance Plus

Rules of Play

Insurance Plus is a variation to the standard game of Blackjack. The game is played using one, two, four, six or eight decks of 52 cards. After players have received their two original cards, if the dealer has a ten-value card showing, the player has the option to bet up to one-half of their original wager on the 'Insurance Plus.'

If the dealer has a blackjack or a final score of 20 or 21, the player will be paid according to the following payable regardless of what the player has:

Dealer's Final Total	Paytable A
20	Push
Blackjack	4 to 1
21	5 to 1

Dealer's Final Total	Paytable B	Paytable C	Paytable D
Any 20	Push	Push	Push
Any 21	6 to 1	6 to 1	6 to 1
Blackjack	3 to 1	3 to 1	3 to 1
Suited Blackjack	6 to 1	4 to 1	3 to 1

(Note: Paytables B-D played with 2 through 8 decks only.)

After the "Insurance Plus" wagers have been resolved, the regular game of blackjack will continue.
