



Lucky Cat Blackjack™

RULES

Lucky Cat Blackjack is played with two, six or eight standard 52 card decks. To begin, players make the standard Blackjack wager. Each player and the dealer then receive two cards.

Play continues in standard Blackjack fashion according to the following rules:

Dealer hits Soft 17.

Blackjacks pay 3:2 or 6:5.

Players may split up to three times (maximum four hands).

Aces may or may not be resplit (operator's discretion).

Split Aces may not be hit or doubled.

Players may double down after splitting.

No surrender offered.

If the dealer's final hand total is 22, four 'Lucky Cat' dice are rolled. All unresolved hands, including splits and/or doubles are won or pushed based on the number of cats shown on the dice. The 'Lucky Cat' feature pays odds according to the paytables below:

Number of 'Lucky Cats'	Paytable 1	Paytable 2
4	100 to 1	50 to 1
3	10 to 1	10 to 1
2	3 to 1	2 to 1
1	1 to 1	1 to 1
0	Push	Push

Note: The Lucky Cat dice are six-sided. Five sides are blank and one side has an image of a cat.

Optional version:

If dealer busts, three Lucky Cat dice are rolled. All unresolved hands, including splits and/or doubles are won or pushed based on the number of cats shown on the dice.

The 'Lucky Cat' feature pays odds according to the paytables below:

Number of 'Lucky Cats'	Paytable 1	Paytable 2
3, Same Color	10 to 1	10 to 1
3, Mixed Color	3 to 1	4 to 1
2	3 to 2	3 to 2
1	1 to 1	1 to 1
0	Push	Push

Note: The Lucky Cat dice are six-sided. Four sides are blank and one side has an image of a gold cat, and one side has an image of a white cat.
