

MGM Roulette

Rules of Play

MGM Roulette is a variation of Roulette played with a 39-spot wheel, consisting of the numbers 1-36, 0, 00, and a non-numerical 39th spot. The 39th spot, like 0 or 00, counts as neither red nor black, nor odd, nor even.

The player begins by placing one or more of the available wagers. The game is otherwise played in the same manner as standard Roulette. The pays for each available wager are as follows:

- Single Number (Straight Up) – Ball lands on a chosen number or non-numerical 39th spot and pays 35 to 1.
- Two Numbers (Split) - Ball lands on one of two adjacent numbers and pays 17 to 1.
- Three Numbers - Ball lands on one of three numbers in a row, or the combination of (0/00/non-numeric 39th spot) or (0/1/2) or (00/2/3) or (0/00/2) and pays 11 to 1.
- Four Numbers (Corner) – Ball lands on one of four numbers that meet on a corner and pays 8 to 1
- Top Line – Ball lands on one of the combination of numbers that include (0/00/1/2/3) and pays 6 to 1. This bet will not include the non-numerical 39th spot.
- Six Numbers - Ball lands on one of six numbers that are in two adjacent rows and pays 5 to 1.
- Twelve Numbers – Ball lands in a chosen twelve number section and pays 2 to 1. These groupings include: 1st dozen, 2nd dozen, 3rd dozen, and the three columns located at the bottom of the layout.
- Eighteen Numbers – Ball lands in a chosen eighteen number grouping and pays 1 to 1. These groupings include: red, black, odd, even, 1 to 18, and 18 to 36.

Note: The 39th spot is intended to be visually configured by the operator, but the functionality remains the same. The 39th spot will have a symbol that is reflective to the MGM Resorts International property that it is located at. For example, New York New York will have an apple as its symbol, and Bellagio will have its signature B as its symbol.
