PAIR – VERSION 3 GAME RULES

PAIR - Version 3 is an optional side wager that may be played on all standard Blackjack games with two (2), six (6), or eight (8) decks. The PAIR – Version 3 sidebet is based off the player's first two cards and the dealer's "up" card and pays according to the posted payable.

Definitions:

- Royal Flush is a three (3) card hand where all cards are the same suit and consist of the ranks Ace, King, and Queen.
- 3 of a Kind (Suited) is a three (3) card hand where all cards are the same rank and suit.
- 3 of a Kind (Mixed) is a three (3) card hand where all cards are the same rank.
- Player Pair (Suited) is when both of the player's initial two (2) cards are the same rank and suit.
- Any Pair (Suited) is when any two (2) of the three (3) cards dealt in the three (3) card hand are the same rank and suit.
- Flush is when all three (3) of the cards in the three (3) card hand are the same suit.
- Player Pair (Mixed) is when both of the player's initial two (2) cards are the same rank.
- Any Pair (Mixed) is when any two (2) of the three (3) cards dealt in the three (3) card hand are the same rank.
- 3 of a Kind is either 3 of a Kind (Suited) or 3 of a kind (Mixed).
- Player Pair is either Player Pair (Suited) or Player Pair (Mixed).
- Any Pair is either Any Pair (Suited) or Any Pair (Mixed).

Pair Version 3 is an additional wager that may be placed by a Player and wins if the initial three (3) cards dealt can form a Royal Flush, 3 of a Kind Suited, 3 of a Kind Mixed, Player Pair (suited), Player Pair (Mixed), Any Pair (Suited), Any Pair (Mixed) or Flush.

- Only the highest result is paid.

How to Play:

1. Main Blackjack wager must be placed to wager on the PAIR – Version 3 sidebet.
2. All wagers must be placed prior to any cards being dealt.
3. Once wagers are set, cards will be dealt according to the house procedures.
4. After the initial two cards have been dealt, the dealer will settle all PAIR – Version 3 wagers working counter-clockwise (right to left), placing any losing wager into the rack. When paying a winning wager, the dealer will also hand back the original PAIR – Version 3 wager to the guest so only the base Blackjack wager remains in the betting area.
5. Once all PAIR – Version 3 wagers have been resolved, the standard game of Blackjack may resume.
