



Rules of Play

“Pair it Up” is a variation of Blackjack, played using six or eight standard 52-card decks dealing face-up or face-down. All regular blackjack rules apply to the main game. To begin, the player must wager on the standard game of blackjack and may optionally wager on the “Pair it Up” side bets. Player must place wagers before receiving their first card.

While playing the game of “**Pair It Up™**” Blackjack a player will have 3 separate side bets they can bet on with 3 different opportunities to win within those side bets.

Side Bet Options:

Player/Dealer Pair (*1st cards only*)

Player/Dealer is determined after 1 card has been dealt to each player and the dealer. After the first cards have been dealt, this bet is either paid or removed from the table before play continues.

Player Pair

Player Pair is determined after the first 2 cards have been dealt to the player. This bet is either paid or removed from the table before the blackjack hand is played out.

Dealer Pair

Dealer Pair is unique, fun, and exciting for the player because although the other 2 pair bets will be determined before the blackjack hand is played out, the dealer pair bet will remain on the table until after the dealer second card is revealed. Even if the player loses their hand, their saving grace could be winning the dealer pair side bet.

There are three payout options for the Player/Dealer Pair, Player Pair, and the Dealer Pair.

- Suited Pair- 25 to 1
- Colored Pair- 12 to 1
- Mixed Pair- 6 to 1
