



PARLAY 21

GAME RULES:

Parlay 21 is a variation to the standard game of Blackjack that is played using 1, 2, 6 or 8 decks of 52 cards. Parlay 21 adds two optional side bets to Blackjack based upon the color of the dealer's up card.

To begin, the player places a main Blackjack wager and either a RED side bet **OR** a BLACK side bet. As per the standard Blackjack dealing procedure; after all wagers have been placed, the dealer will deal the first two cards of Blackjack to each player and the dealer, exposing the dealer's up card.

If the dealer's up card is RED (Heart or Diamond) the dealer will pay even-money to all side bets placed on RED, and collect all side bets placed on BLACK. Alternately, if the dealer's up card is BLACK (Spade or Club) the dealer will pay even-money to all side bets placed on BLACK and collect all side bets placed on RED.

Winning RED or BLACK side bets **MUST** be parlayed, in which the side bet plus the payoff is added to the main Blackjack wager prior to completing the hand of Blackjack. The dealer caps the already placed main Blackjack wager with the winning RED or BLACK side bet plus the payoff, and completes the primary game of Blackjack according the Blackjack rules set by the house.

OPTIONAL 6:5/3:2 RULE:

The player is paid 3:2 if they receive a natural Blackjack with a Black Ace and a natural Blackjack with a Red Ace pays 6:5.
