

Player's Jackpot 21 V2

Rules of Play

Player's Jackpot 21 is a variation of the standard game of blackjack. The game is an optional side wager played using a single deck of 52 cards and one additional Joker, or multiple decks with a Joker with each deck, or three Jokers with a six deck shoe.

Players make the standard blackjack wager and the Player's Jackpot 21 side wager. This wager is placed in a side pool/pot.

The game of Blackjack is dealt per standard rules. The player who is dealt the Joker wins the pool/pot. If multiple decks are used and more than one Joker is in play, the player who receives the first Joker wins the pool/pot.

The operator may opt to collect a 5% vigorish out of the pot each time it is won; or they may take a 1-unit vigorish as long as the unit represents no more than a maximum of 20% of the pot.

If the Joker is not dealt, the pool/pot would roll over to the next game.

If the Joker comes into play in the dealer's hand, it is immediately discarded and another card is dealt.
