

## **Rio Baccarat Prop Bets**

### **Rules of Play**

Rio Baccarat Prop Bets is played using standard 52 card decks. The game is an optional side wager based on the Player hand and/or the Banker hand.

The prop bets allow players to first wager that the Player hand and/or the Banker hand will or will not receive a natural as follows:

- Both Naturals – Player and Banker receive a natural (8 or 9) pays 20 to 1.
- Either Natural – Either or both Player and Banker receive a natural pays 3 to 2.
- Neither Natural – Player nor Banker receives a natural pays 2 to 5.

If neither Player nor Banker receives a natural, the game proceeds as normal and players may have the following additional options to 'insure' their wagers:

- If Banker's two card total equals 7 and Player's two card total is less than 6, Banker can insure his hand against a loss. Banker bettor may wager up to 1/5 of initial wager that Player hand will win (i.e. score 8 or 9). The winning insurance wager pays 5 to 1. Insurance wager loses if Player score is any value less than 8.
- If Player's two card total equals 6 and Banker's two card total is less than 6, Player can insure his hand against a loss. Player bettor may wager up to 1/3 of initial wager that Banker hand will win (i.e. score 7, 8, or 9). The winning insurance wager pays 3 to 1. Insurance wager loses if player score is any value less than 7.
- If Player's two card total equals 7 and Banker's two card total is less than 6, Player can insure his hand against a loss. Player bettor may wager up to 1/5 of initial wager that Banker hand will win (i.e. score 8 or 9). The winning insurance wager pays 5 to 1. Insurance wager loses if Player score is any value less than 8.
