



Rules and Dealing Procedures

Introduction:

River Hold'em is an exciting poker derivative dealt like Texas Hold'em where players place bets as their hand is revealed. All players and dealer will use their two hole cards combined with the 5 community cards to make their best 5 card poker hand.

To Play:

1. Players must make an Ante bet and may also make the optional Player Trips and/or Dealer Trips Bonus bets prior to any cards being dealt.
2. Each player and the dealer are dealt two cards face down starting with the player to the left of the dealer.
3. After seeing their two cards, players must bet 1x their Ante on the Before Flop bet or fold. If the player folds, the Ante loses. Any Player Trips/Dealer Trips Bonus bets remain in action.
4. The dealer reveals the 3 card flop and the players must bet 1x their Ante on the After Flop bet or fold. If the player folds, the Ante and Before Flop bets lose. Any Player/Dealer Trips Bonus bets remain in action.
5. Finally, the dealer reveals the Turn and River cards. Players must bet 1x or 2x their Ante on the Turn/River bet or fold. If the player folds, the Ante, Before Flop, and After Flop bets lose. Any Player/Dealer Trips Bonus bets remain in action.
6. The dealer will then reveal his two hole cards and combine them with the 5 community cards to make his best 5 card poker hand and compare his hand against each player's hand.

Winning and Losing:

- Dealer always qualifies.
- If the player's hand beats the dealer's hand with a Full House or better:
 - The Ante wager pays even money.
 - The Before Flop, After Flop and Turn/River wagers pay odds according to the posted payable.
- If the player's hand beats the dealer's hand with a Flush or lower:
 - The Ante wager pushes.
 - The Before Flop, After Flop and Turn/River wagers pay odds according to the posted payable.
- If the player's hand and the dealer's hand tie:
 - The Ante, Before Flop, After Flop and Turn/River wagers push.
- If the dealer's hand beats the player's hand:
 - The Ante, Before Flop, After Flop and Turn/River wagers lose.

Optional Wagers:

The Player Trips and Dealer Trips Bonus bets are optional wagers and are paid according to the posted payable. The Player Trips wins if the player's 5 card hand consists of a three-of-a-kind or better. The Dealer Trips wins if the dealer's 5 card hand consists of a three-of-a-kind or better. If these bets are placed, they are paid regardless of whether the player's hand beats the dealer's and vice versa.
