

ROULETTE UP

Game Description

Roulette Up is an optional bonus and progressive wager for Roulette games. Players wager that the numbers spun will be in an increasing sequence. The wagers are paid based on the streak length (amount of spins of increasing numbers) before the streak ends.

Rules of Play

Players are required to maintain the minimum table wager on the base game in order to place a *Roulette Up* bonus and/or progressive wager or follow house rules.

1. To begin each round, players place their base game wagers and, optionally, a *Roulette Up* bonus and/or progressive wager.
2. The first spin after the wagers are placed establishes the starting number. A lammer or dolly is placed in the "1" box of the *Up Streak* tracker denoting the current streak length is 1. Additional *Roulette Up* wagers will not be accepted until the current streak (round) ends.
3. The wager is active for as long as each subsequent spin is a greater number than the previous number. The streak length is tracked on the *Up Streak* tracker after each increasing number is spun. Also, note that:
 - a. For American Roulette, 00 is considered greater than 0 and less than 1.
4. The wager ends when either:
 - a. The most recent number spun is less than or equal to the previous number.
 - b. The most recent number spun is 36 (which cannot be exceeded).
 - c. The longest streak length available on the posted *Roulette Up* payable(s) has been reached.
 - d. Note that any of the above streak-ending events do not move the *Up Streak* tracker (e.g., increase the streak length).
5. Once the streak ends, the dealer reconciles any *Roulette Up* bonus and/or progressive wagers according to the streak length, as posted on the corresponding payable(s).
6. Once reconciled, wagering on *Roulette Up* becomes available and a new round begins.

Example Streak Lengths

1. After bets are made, the numbers spun are 5, 22, 31, 25.
 - a. Streak length is 3
 - b. Streak ends because 25 is not greater than 31
2. After bets are made, the numbers spun are 6, 4.
 - a. Streak length is 1
 - b. Streaks ends because 4 is not greater than 6
3. After bets are made, the numbers spun are 36.
 - a. Streak length is 1
 - b. Streaks ends because no number is greater than 36
4. After bets are made, the numbers spun are 9, 11, 20, 21, 36.
 - a. Streak length is 5
 - b. Streaks ends because no number is greater than 36
5. After bets are made, the numbers spun are 10, 19, 19.
 - a. Streak length is 2
 - b. Streaks ends because 19 is not greater than 19
