

## Rules for OptionBlackjack:

OptionBlackjack (OB) is played almost identically to traditional Blackjack (BJ).

The pay tables for both OB and BJ are identical and interchangeable.

The rules are also identical and interchangeable with the following exception explained:

OB is played with either 6 or 8 decks of standard playing cards. The decks are shuffled together until random. By approximation, the dealer will cut away 75% of the cards and place them in the main (black) shoe. The remaining 25% will be placed in the auxiliary (red) shoe. The dealer will draw everyone's first two cards from the main shoe. On the custom layout, on both sides of the player's betting circle, will be a black and red dragon, respectively. In turn, each player will have "the option" to draw card/s from either the main or auxiliary shoe. To hit/split/double down, the player will tap on the colored dragon to indicate shoe preference. The dealer will always draw card/s from the main shoe, regarding the dealer's hand. Each shoe will have its own cut card to indicate when the last hand is played before the reshuffle. Again, all rules and pay tables are identical and interchangeable to traditional BJ.
