

SEVEN CARD STUD LINKED PROGRESSIVE

Game Description

The **Seven Card Stud Linked Progressive** is an optional progressive side bet for the following games played using a standard 52-card deck of cards. To begin, players must make the required base game wager to place the **Seven Card Stud Linked Progressive** side bet on the following games.

- All In Stud
- Cajun Stud
- Four Card Frenzy
- Four Card Prime
- High Card Flush
- Three Card Prime
- World Poker Tour (WPT) Heads Up Hold'em

Players are paid against a payable if they are able to create a qualifying five card hand that uses the player's cards combined with the **Seven Card Stud Linked Progressive** community cards as follows:

- All In Stud: The *Seven Card Stud Linked Progressive* hand is formed by combining the player's three card hand with the four *Seven Card Stud Linked Progressive* community cards.
- Cajun Stud: The *Seven Card Stud Linked Progressive* hand is formed by combining the player's two card hand with the five *Seven Card Stud Linked Progressive* community cards.
- Four Card Frenzy: The *Seven Card Stud Linked Progressive* hand is formed by combining the player's five card hand with the two *Seven Card Stud Linked Progressive* community cards.
- Four Card Prime: The *Seven Card Stud Linked Progressive* hand is formed by combining the player's five card hand with the two *Seven Card Stud Linked Progressive* community cards.
- High Card Flush: The *Seven Card Stud Linked Progressive* hand is formed using the player's seven card hand.
- Three Card Prime: The *Seven Card Stud Linked Progressive* hand is formed by combining the player's three card hand with the with the four *Seven Card Stud Linked Progressive* community cards.
- World Poker Tour (WPT) Heads Up Hold'em: *Seven Card Stud Linked Progressive* hand is formed by combining the player's two card hand with the five face down *Seven Card Stud Linked Progressive* community cards.

Additionally, paytables PT-BJS-7CL-E01, PT-BJS-7CL-E02, and PT-BJS-7CL-E03 award a fixed Envy pay to other wagering players. To qualify for an Envy pay, at least one player must win a progressive award with a Royal Flush hand. All other players who have placed the progressive wager, but have not received the Royal Flush progressive award, will receive the listed Envy pay.
