



### Rules of Play

Super Shot 21 is a variation to the standard game of Blackjack. The game is played using two or six decks of 52 cards.

- To begin, each player must place the primary wager and optionally the Any Pair, Flush Plus and/or Bonus side wagers before any cards are dealt.
- Once all wagers are placed, the Dealer will deal blackjack according to the house procedures.
- The Any Pair, Flush Plus and Bonus side wagers are resolved based on the player's first two cards and the dealers up card.
- If the side wager qualifies for a payoff, the dealer will pay the wager according to the posted payable (see samples below).

#### Any Pair Paytables

\*Dealer Envy payout of 1 to 1 awarded to dealer when player forms three-of-a-kind.

#### Flush Plus-Paytables

Hand	Pays 1	Pays 2	Pays 3	Pays 4
Straight Flush	30 to 1	30 to 1	40 to 1	10 to 1
3 of a Kind	20 to 1	20 to 1	30 to 1	20 to 1
Straight	10 to 1	10 to 1	12 to 1	10 to 1
Flush	6 to 1	7 to 1	4 to 1	7 to 1

#### Bonus-Paytables

Hand*	Pays
Option 1 – Straight Flush	425 to 1
Option 2 – 3 of a Kind	225 to 1
Option 3 – Straight Flush/Straight	25 to 1
Option 4 – Straight Flush/Flush	15 to 1

\*Licensee will choose one of the four independent wagering options for use.

If the side wager (s) lose, the wagers (s) will be collected immediately before normal blackjack play continues.

Note: It is the Licensee discretion to offer one, two, or three of the Super Shot 21 side wagers. Licensee determines all maximum /minimum betting limits.
